Based on the current market trends, it can be observed that there is a high demand for Japanese vehicles, especially Japanese domestic models (JDMs) due to the fact that such cars are known for their superior quality when compared to Indian-manufactured vehicles and the affordable prices when compared to European models. Moreover, they hold a comparatively higher resale value.

A brand-new Indian Alto 800 sells today at 2.7 million rupees, whereas the resale price of cars of the same model which were manufactured in 2015 is between 1.7-1.8 million. That is a 33% depreciation from the



price of a brand-new car.

Since there is no significant demand for second-hand Korean and Indian vehicles, if you opt for such a model, it would be rather difficult to recover the investment made when purchasing the car. Hence, the owner has no choice but to use that car for as long as he can.

Due to the proven quality, high-tech options and the availability of spare parts and accessories, registered (or second-hand) JDM cars have a good demand in the market. For an instance, an unregistered JDM Alto car sells today between 2.6-2.7 million rupees; while a car of the same model manufactured in 2015 is valued between 2.1-2.2 million rupees. That is only a 18% depreciation from the price of an unregistered car.

Moreover, a JDM Toyota Vitz manufactured in 2018 currently sells between 4-4.3 million rupees, whereas cars of the same model which were manufactured in 2017 can be bought at 3.5-3.8 million rupees.
